Shea butter

The shea butter that we offer comes from years of passion from our producer. It all started with an observation: why was the shea butter available on the market so different from the miracle product described in pharmacy and medical theses?

Where was this fabulous product with its nourishing, healing, protective and disinfecting power? All that was available was either white and inert fat, industrial shea butter, or a natural but rancid butter with an unbearable smell.

The shea butter we propose is the result of these years of research and development, notably in the comparison and analysis of different butters, establishing a relationship between sunshine and rainfall with the result obtained.

This unique know-how allows us to obtain a product of exceptional quality and freshness that retains all its beneficial properties.



From West Africa

In West Africa, the shea tree grows wild in the sub-Saharan savannah, without pesticides or excessive watering to force it to develop. This growth according to the rains and the diversity of the soils produces almonds of a great cosmetic and gustatory richness, they are called "the gold of women".

Each step of the process is based on ancestral know-how to achieve an astonishingly high quality result. The extraction protocol used means that there is no equivalent product on the market in terms of quality, authenticity and purity.

Each year, an audit conducted by Ecocert certifies the butter as Organic and Fair Trade (FFL - Fair For Life).

The shea butter has not undergone any refining operation, which preserves its intrinsic qualities.



The process

The almonds are washed, dried and then sorted to eliminate any almonds that show signs of oxidation or are less than perfect.

The almonds are then roasted in small batches to be ground and processed to extract the butter. The method used is manual and gentle. It is done at low temperature (<90°C). The butter is then filtered and put in 2 kg bags.

This method guarantees the best possible quality, but takes three times longer and gives a yield of 25 to 35% less depending on the harvest.
